Our commitment to serve

Driven by the vision that everyone needs a decent place to live, Habitat for Humanity began in 1976 as a grassroots effort on a community farm in southern Georgia. Founded in Christian values, our mission is **seeking to put God's love into action, Habitat for Humanity brings people together to build homes, communities, and hope.** The organization has since grown to become a leading global nonprofit working in nearly 1,400 communities throughout the U.S. and in nearly 70 countries.

Then in 1985, Chrys and John Street of Georgia met Millard Fuller, who challenged them to start an affiliate of Habitat for Humanity in Cobb County. They distributed brochures to local churches and gathered 12 people to form a Board of Directors. On April 1, 1986, Cobb County Habitat for Humanity was officially incorporated as an affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International. In 2008, the organization expanded to include Douglas and Paulding counties and the name changed to Habitat for Humanity of Northwest Metro Atlanta. Since 1986, we have built over 500 homes, and rehabilitated or repaired many more as part of our pursuit to provide decent, affordable housing in Cobb, Douglas, and Paulding counties. These vital efforts continue today as we strive to achieve proper housing for all families in need in our communities.





What we do

Through our efforts to achieve the vision of everyone having a decent place to live, we offer a variety of programs in which sponsors and volunteers can get involved, including:

- House builds: New-construction home builds for first-time homeowners that qualify,
- Habitat ReStore: Selling new and gentlyused items to raise more funds to build homes,
- Special events: Hosting events throughout the year raising additional funds to support our mission,
- Advocacy: Meeting with local legislators and representatives to advocate for affordable housing policy and local partnerships to help that happen





Ownership of a decent, affordable home has a direct impact on a family's quality of life.


A healthy quality of life includes the following:

As one partner of many involved in a neighborhood's framework, Habitat can create a mix of affordable housing products and services to help measurably improve overall quality of life in many communities. Partners with us in this effort might offer help in reducing crime, building parks, making jobs more available, and improving education outcomes. Habitat also assesses quality of life outcomes by evaluating factors affecting a family prior to and after moving into their new Habitat home.

Ultimate outcome: improved quality of life – the sense of well-being and happiness experienced by individuals, groups, and communities.

American Dream Sponsor

\$165,000

American Dream Sponsors enjoy an experience reserved solely for their company, family, or coalition. Or if they desire, to partner with additional sponsors and volunteers to build together.

You may choose between two options at this level:

- 1. Build in one location, where you and the future homeowner build together over nine (9) volunteer days, OR
- 2. **Multiple locations**, where your team chooses to build across various Habitat homes over nine (9) volunteer days.

In addition to the sponsor amount above, the sponsor agrees to provide lunches, ice, and drinks for all nine (9) build days for all volunteers and crew leaders (approx. 40 people per day days 1-8, and 50 people on day 9). Sponsor will need to assign someone to deliver these items on each build day.

Sponsor benefits include:

- Naming rights to one Habitat house, or shared with co-sponsors on multiple homes
- Two (2) press releases

- Nine (9) reserved build days for your organization/coalition/family to volunteer on the build

Raising Walls Sponsor:

\$55,000

Raising Walls Sponsors enjoy three (3) build days reserved solely for their company, family, or coalition, for a total of 25 volunteers per day.

In addition to the sponsor amount above, the sponsor agrees to provide lunches, ice, and drinks for all three (3) build days for all volunteers and crew leaders (approx. 40 people per day days 1-8, and 50 people on day 9). Sponsor will need to assign someone to deliver these items on each build day.

Sponsor benefits include:

- Three (3) reserved build days for your organization to volunteer

\$20,000

Sponsors of an individual build day enjoy one (1) full build day reserved solely for their company, family, or coalition, for 25 volunteers.

In addition to the sponsor amount above, the sponsor agrees to provide lunches, ice, and drinks for your sponsored build day for all volunteers and crew leaders (approx. 40 people per day days 1-8, and 50 people on day 9). Sponsor will need to assign someone to deliver these items on your build day.

Sponsor benefits include:

- Two (2) social media posts
- Logo on Habitat website sponsor page
- One (1) reserved build day (with additional volunteers Habitat will select should your group have less than 15 volunteers)

Shared Build Day:

\$5,000 - \$10,000

Volunteers work under the guidance of construction professionals, alongside other volunteers and future Habitat homeowners.
